I. Course Summary

Openbravo POS is a point of sale application designed for touch screens, supports ESC/POS receipt printers, customer displays and barcode scanners. It is multiuser and has a great backoffice with a product entry form, reports and charts.

This is a 2 days training for partners, potential partners and users. The objectives are to learn about the functionalities of Openbravo POS and how to successfully install and configure it to match the users' requirements.

II. Audience: Who is training aimed at?

This training is intended for current partners, consultants, developers, and any trainee looking to analyze the capabilities of Openbravo POS and/or implement it.

It is also very valuable for current Openbravo ERP implementors and users that want to complement Openbravo ERP with a point of sale application.

Session	Description	Objectives	Duration
0 – Introduction to Openbravo POS	Introduction to Openbravo POS including all sides: functionality, installation, configuration and administration.	Understand the overall picture. Understand what will you learn during the course and how should you approach to optimize learning.	2 hours
1 – Operations management	Sales processes, refunds, cash management and daily reports,	Understand how to use Openbravo POS in a normal working day from the sales person and manager point of view. Be able to create and edit receipts, refunds, execute daily reports, create cash movements.	2 hours
2 - Warehouse Management	Warehouses and locations. Physical inventory, movements between warehouses and reports.	Understand how this functionality works. Be able to edit the master tables: products, categories, warehouses. Create movements of material between warehouses, material receptions, execute current inventory reports and inventory movement reports.	2 hours
3 – Installation of Openbravo POS and hardware	Installation of Openbravo POS in different environments. Synchronization with Openbravo ERP. Installation and operation of the point of sale hardware supported.	Be able to install Openbravo POS according to the needs of a specific client and how to connect the different points of sale. Understand how to install and configure the hardware required for each point of sale: Receipt printers, customer displays, cash drawers, touch screen, bar code scanners, scales	2 hours
4 – Administration and basic configuration	Administration of users, roles and permissions. Basic configuration and personalization. Restaurant module. Taxes management.	Be able to create users, roles and authorizations to the different menu options and actions of Openbravo POS. Understand the resources table and how to edit the title of the application, logo, and other options of Openbravo POS. Be able to configure the restaurant module. Edition of floors and tables. Understand the taxes management and how to create receipts with taxes included or excluded.	3 hours



Session	Description	Objectives	Duration
5 – Advanced configuration and customization	Development of receipt and customer display templates. Development of macro buttons for the sales panel. Development of new reports and charts. <i>Includes Exercises.</i>	Understand the advanced possibilities of Openbravo POS. Understand the template layout used to print receipts and to print to the customer display and be able to create complex receipts. Understand the macro language embedded in Openbravo POS and be able to create macros for printing receipts, apply discounts... Be able to create new reports and charts and include in the menu of Openbravo POS.	3 hours

IV. Requirements

Participants will be required to bring a laptop to the training. It is recommendable that a java IDE (such as Eclipse) is installed in the laptop. A working Openbravo ERP installation is also required to perform the integration exercises.

Participants are expected to have a general understanding of POS systems and must be knowledgeable in SQL and java.

V. Language

Trainings are given in Spanish, however the written documentation will be provided in English.
